



**PIECE HALL, HALIFAX
HARGREAVES DRAINAGE LIMITED**



The Piece Hall is a very special part of Halifax's architectural heritage.

Built in the eighteenth century to meet the needs of the burgeoning wool trade, it now carries a Grade 1 listing status. In its recent redevelopment, careful specification was required to ensure both the harmonious appearance and integrity of the Hall were maintained when it came to replacing old guttering and pipes.

The Piece Hall is a vast building, originally comprising more than 300 rooms, and the guttering order was correspondingly large with more than 380 gutter lengths, 110 rainwater pipe lengths and fittings delivered to site.



Hargreaves Drainage supplied Premier extra sand cast H16 moulded gutters and fittings and Premier Extra standard round rainwater pipes that were perfectly in keeping with the building. The gutters were finished in a special sand colour specified by Calderdale MBC's Building Consultancy Department to complement the Yorkshire stone of the Hall.
