

SOCIAL HOUSING, WEST MOSELEY MARLEY ALUTEC



Requiring little or no maintenance, products from Marley Alutec's Evolve rainwater and Evoke eaves solutions ranges were recently specified for the renovation of PA Housing's The Fairway, to reduce the scheme's operational costs long term.

In line with PA Housing's mission to provide safe, pleasant homes and neighbourhoods where people have pride in their surroundings, the renovation of the three-storey building in West Moseley included the replacement of the rainwater system, fascias and soffits, which had reached the end of their life.

We therefore wanted products that would require minimal maintenance over time."

Marley Alutec's Evolve deepflow round guttering and Evoke fascias and soffits were chosen, as the aluminium systems have a life expectancy of up to 50 years or more. Highly corrosion resistant, they will never rust or need re-painting. In addition, the Evoke range is also available in a choice of 12 PVDF paint options, which includes Nano surface technology able to resist the build-up of dust, grime and algae, reducing the need for regular maintenance further.



Roofline specialists RC Grant & Sons Ltd installed the Evoke and Evolve systems. "We've worked with Marley Alutec before and we have a great working relationship," said Adam Farrell, contracts manager at RC Grant.
