

SAINT MARY'S PARISH CHURCH, KIRKINTILLOCH

St Mary's Church which can be found in Kirkintilloch is part of the Church of Scotland with the Glasgow Presbytery. The church was completed in 1914 and is famous for its striking stained-glass windows.

Unfortunately, like many Victorian churches, the Grade B listed St Mary's required major restoration work to be carried out on the roof, including replacement cast iron gutters, downpipe and hoppers.

Funding for this work was received from Historic Scotland & Historic Environment Scotland lottery funds, the grant enabled the church to undertake urgent restoration works to the roofs of the chancel and main structure, as well as repairing guttering and drainage, and restoring external masonry.

Saint Gobain PAM were chosen to supply their Classical 6 x 4 No46 moulded gutter, 75mm BS460 un-eared downpipe & A485 rectangular hoppers and completed a site survey followed by a detailed bill of materials to the contractors.



Information provided by the site visit allowed G&A Plumbing who installed the cast iron rainwater system the time to order the materials from the Wolseley branch in Falkirk and meeting the timescales request by main contractor Stewart & Shields.
