

APPLETREE COTTAGE, THE COTSWOLDS

Design Storey architects are thrilled with the transformation of this curtilage-listed coach house located in a walled garden within a conservation area in a small Cotswold town. The task was to extend the ground floor of the property to create a new boot room and dining room, increase the amount of light into the property and improve connection of the house with the garden.

The project proved particularly tricky due to the listed and conservation status which made selection of materials especially sensitive. Having specified Lindab guttering for these reasons and for its longevity and minimal appearance, the architect was assisted with samples so that the client could choose their colour palette on site.

They opted for Anthracite Metallic coated finish gutters and downpipes and square hoppers which the architect said, *“contributed to the overall quality of the build and visual appearance of the final building”*.
